
# USA Free Trade Agreements

Australia, Bahrain, Canada , Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Jordan, Korea, Mexico , Morocco, Nicaragua, Oman, Panama, Peru, Singapore

Qualifying goods via the African Growth and Opportunity Act (AGOA) and the Caribbean Basin Trade Partnership Act (CBTPA) may qualify for dutyfree import.
