\*All goods that are restricted, controlled or regulated by another government department are not eligible to be imported under de minimis regulations and must have a formal customs entry. If applicable, these commodities valued under \$40.00 require Entry Preparation and a \$7.00 fee per entry will be applied.

#### **Disbursement Fees**

Customers are responsible for payment of any applicable duties and taxes on their import shipments. When UPS remits payment of duty/tax to the Canada Border Services Agency on behalf of the customer, UPS will invoice the customer

for the amount paid and a Disbursement Fee will apply. The applicable Disbursement Fee is the greater of 3.7% of the duty/tax amount or \$7 on UPS Standard service or \$11 on UPS Worldwide Express Plus, UPS Worldwide Express, UPS Worldwide Express Freight,

Worldwide Express Freight Midday, UPS Worldwide Express Saver and UPS Worldwide Expedited service. To avoid Disbursement Fees, call 1-800-PICK-UPS® and ask about our Prepayment or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) plans.

## Information on Import Fees on Shipments into Canada from International Origins

#### **Duties and Taxes**

- The Importer of Record is responsible for paying duties and taxes unless otherwise specified at the time of shipment preparation.
- Duties and taxes are determined and applied by the country in which the goods arrive.
- All shipments being imported are subject to inspection by the CBSA or partner government agencies.
- If you are importing goods into Canada from the U.S. or Mexico, ask your supplier to provide the applicable CUSMA Certificate of Origin so the goods will be rated at the lowest possible rate allowed under CUSMA Rules of Origin (if applicable).
- UPS Customs Brokerage can still handle your imports without a UPS Importer Account Number, but all amounts owing on the import (freight charges, duties and taxes.
- customs brokerage fees as applicable) must be paid online prior to delivery\* or will be payable C.O.D. when UPS® delivers the imported shipment to your door. In addition, you will be charged an additional I.C.O.D Fee for collecting these import charges upon delivery.

With a UPS Importer Account, all your import charges will be billed directly to your account and no I.C.O.D Fee will apply.

## **Customs Brokerage Services**

- Customs brokers are licensed by the CBSA in customs clearance procedures and are employed to act on the importer's behalf.
- In Canada, the Importer of Record must officially designate a customs broker by signing a General Agency Agreement, giving their customs broker Power of Attorney to act on their behalf. UPS must be selected as the designated customs broker for our guaranteed service to be applicable.

### **Customs Brokerage Fees**

The customs brokerage fees that may apply to a shipment fall into three main categories:

## Additional Fees

## **Duty and Tax Recovery Services**

- Duty and Tax Amendment: UPS can file an amendment with the CBSA to correct inaccurate customs-related information on your entry documents. A fee applies for this service.
- Low-Value Shipment Amendment:
   UPS can correct any customs-related

information on your entry documents for shipments valued at less than \$3,300. The error must be identified on or before the 10th of the month following the import date. If the error is identified after the 10th of the following month, a Duty and Tax Amendment must be completed. A fee applies for this service.

#### Clearance Services and Related Fees

FedEx provides import clearance processing for international express package and international express freight shipments, and international ground shipments. FedEx may charge a clearance service fee, where applicable, on international shipments for clearance processing; for services requested by the shipper, recipient, or importer of record; or to recover the costs passed to FedEx by the regulatory agency for regulatory filing. Clearance service fees that are invoiced are described on a separate line item on the duty-and-tax invoice.

We may apply these service fees, which are subject to change, to either a U.S.- or non-U.S.-based shipper, recipient, or designated third party. When possible, we will honor the shipper's request to bill these service fees to the payer as designated on the Bill Duties and Taxes section of the air waybill or shipping label. When we are unable to honor that request, the recipient may be invoiced for applicable clearance service.

When the Bill Shipper or Bill Third Party option is selected to pay duty-and-tax charges, the payer will be invoiced for all applicable clearance service fees that are assessed for clearance in the destination country, including all fees resulting from clearance services that may have been requested by the recipient.
