Accessible Dangerous Goods. Certain dangerous goods must be accessible during transit. You can ship these accessible dangerous goods using FedEx First Overnight [®] , FedEx Priority Overnight [™] , FedEx First Overnight [™] Freight, FedEx 1Day [®] Freight, FedEx International First [™] (U.S. inbound), FedEx International Priority Express, FedEx International Priority, FedEx International Economy (except to Puerto Rico), FedEx International Priority Freight, FedEx International Economy Freight (except to Puerto Rico), FedEx International Premium, and FedEx International Express Freight [™] services.

If applicable, these commodities valued under \$40.00 require Entry Preparation and a \$7.00 fee per entry will be applied.

Disbursement Fees

Customers are responsible for payment of any applicable duties and taxes on their import shipments. When UPS remits payment of duty/tax to the Canada Border Services Agency on behalf of the customer, UPS will invoice the customer

for the amount paid and a Disbursement Fee will apply. The applicable Disbursement Fee is the greater of 3.7% of the duty/tax amount or \$7.40 on UPS Standard service or \$11.65 on UPS Worldwide Express Plus, UPS Worldwide Express, UPS Worldwide Express Freight,

Worldwide Express Freight Middy, UPS Worldwide Express Saver and UPS Worldwide Expedited service. To avoid Disbursement Fees, call 1-800-PICK-UPS[®] and ask about our Prepayment or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) plans.

^{*} The first three classification lines are included in this fee; line charges apply from the fourth line.

^{**} This fee applies to all shipments requiring PGA clearance including, but not limited to, those subject to the Canadian Food Inspection Agency, Health Canada and Natural Resources Canada import requirements.

^{***} This fee applies if the Amendment is submitted on or before the 10th of the month following the import date. If submitted after, the Duty and Tax Amendment applies instead.

^{****} This fee may apply when the included documents are missing critical information and a telephone call or other form of communication is required to obtain the correct information. Examples of missing information include poor descriptions, no country of origin, missing quantities, etc.

[†] Free – When brokerage service for your imports is provided by UPS or its designate, there is no Entry Preparation Fee for routine customs clearance of UPS Worldwide Express Plus, UPS Worldwide Express, UPS Worldwide Express Freight, Worldwide Express Freight Middy, UPS Worldwide Express Saver and UPS Worldwide Expedited shipments, including up to three classification lines. Charges may apply for more complex customs clearance procedures.
