UPS® FTZ Facilitator

With UPS FTZ Facilitator service, importers and exporters have the ability to use UPS to transport international shipments in-bond to and from a global Free/Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ). This service is available for all UPS international shipments, except for UPS® Standard service.

This contractual, fee-based service allows the shipment of goods to and from an FTZ, while retaining the benefits of UPS's transportation network. Using UPS as a single source enables

importers and exporters to increase visibility and tracking, and reduce the chance for errors and costs associated with utilizing multiple transportation providers.

UPS technology enables shipment information and documentation (e.g., the commercial invoice) available to the customer, customer's broker and FTZ operator at the time of export. This enables prompt processing of the FTZ entry.

Importers will choose UPS FTZ Facilitator import service to direct shipments to be delivered in-bond to a designated FTZ rather than being cleared through customs.

Exporters will choose UPS FTZ Facilitator export service to ship goods in-bond from an FTZ to an international destination. Refer to page 195 for fees.

When a shipment is processed as a brokerage-inclusive shipment and FedEx arranges for clearance services, a clearance entry fee is charged to cover processes required to check the Commercial Invoice submitted with the shipment and complete entry preparation procedures required by either U.S. Customs and Border Protection or the Canada Border Services Agency, including calculation of applicable duties and taxes for each type of commodity included in the shipment. The clearance entry fee is subject to all applicable Canadian taxes. Dangerous Goods

Accessible Dangerous Goods. Certain dangerous goods must be accessible during transit. You can ship these accessible dangerous goods using FedEx First Overnight®, FedEx Priority Overnight®, FedEx First Overnight® Freight, FedEx 1Day® Freight, FedEx International First® (U.S. inbound), FedEx International Priority Express, FedEx International Priority, FedEx International Economy (except to Puerto Rico), FedEx International Priority Freight, FedEx International Economy Freight (except to Puerto Rico), FedEx International Premium, and FedEx International Express Freight® services.

- Class 1.4 Explosives
- Class 2.1 Flammable gas
- Class 2.2 Non-flammable gas with a “cargo aircraft only” label
- Class 3 Flammable liquid
- Class 4 Flammable solid, spontaneously combustible, dangerous when wet
- Class 5 Oxidizer and organic peroxide
- Class 8 Corrosive material

Inaccessible Dangerous Goods. You can ship the following dangerous goods classifications via most FedEx services.

- Class 2.2 Non-flammable gas without a “cargo aircraft only” label
- Class 6.1 Toxic
- Class 6.2 Infectious substances
- Class 7 Radioactive materials³
- Class 9 Miscellaneous dangerous goods

You cannot ship dangerous goods of any kind in the FedEx® 10kg Box or FedEx® 25kg Box with the exception of permitted IATA Section II lithium batteries.

Shipments from the U.S. to Puerto Rico that contain dangerous goods or dry ice are assessed the same fees that apply to shipments within the U.S.
